The musical poems of Woody Guthrie, bird songs, and the naturally occurring sounds in nature help babies develop an early appreciation—and accelerated aptitude—for language, movement, and music in this eight-week semester. Your *At Home Materials* include over 25 specially-selected recordings from class, Little Bird Shaker instrument, and Art Banner for the nursery wall that strengthens vision and promotes early literacy.

Village **Do-Si-Do**

Pick up your baby and dance. Do the Charleston, the Tango, and the Cha-Cha and learn why dancing with your baby helps him develop vital learning skills—from head to toe. In this eight-week semester, play over 25 unique instruments and home-made activities. Your *At Home Materials* include over 25 specially-selected recordings from class, a Yellow Do-Si-Do Clacker, and Art Banner for the nursery wall that strengthens vision and promotes early literacy.

Our Time **Wiggles & Giggles**

The more than 30 songs, 15 dances, and eight different instruments create these unique music activities, designed to reflect the importance of movement in the life of a toddler. The double-CD set in your *At Home Materials* features 50 songs, sounds, and recordings of favorite activities from class, plus two story books to develop early literacy skills. Also included is a specially-made zig-zag block instrument to develop rhythm and hand-eye coordination.

Imagine That! **See What I Saw**

In this 15-week semester, your preschooler uses his real experience playing in the park to create imaginative, story-telling scenarios with music. Each week provides your preschooler one uninterrupted session of imaginative play that's guided in a very specific, sequential way—with a special Family Sharing Time with you in the last 15 minutes of class. *At Home Materials* include a CD, Family Activity Book, "Grasshopper Park" game board, plastic and metal slide whistle instrument, and backpack.

Class Descriptions

Family Time **Our Kind of Day**

Build family bonds, creativity, physical and mental development in a delightful one-room schoolhouse. Each week children will listen to instruments and to each other, learn from their peers and older children, and enjoy music and movement with hoops, scarves, and tumble-around play. Story time and family jams, puppet play and happy singing—every *Family Time* activity encourages discovery and exploration and fosters sharing and social skills too. *At Home Materials* include two books—*Bouncing on the Bed and Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes*, two Home CDs, Family Guide, domino game, Hopper the kangaroo hand puppet and Bounce the joey finger puppet, and two double-egg shaker instruments.

Young Child helps every child develop a confident, joyful voice for singing and speaking, as well as essential building blocks for a future of learning. Students explore many facets of the musical experience – speaking, singing, moving, dancing, listening, creating instruments and playing authentic pre-keyboard, string and woodwind instruments. Listen as your child astonishes you with his newfound ability to create musical compositions. **Young Child** provides a pressure-free, developmentally appropriate transition to musically succeed before taking on more formal instruction.
